

My name is Timothy Kickham and I own a single family home located at 24 Worcester Avenue in Falmouth Massachusetts 02540. I object to the plans construed by the Mayflower company to install high voltage transmission lines, underground, beginning at Falmouth Heights beach and being directed down the median strip, through a highly populated, residential and commercial areas, to a location in the center of Falmouth. The department of housing and urban development as well as the Veterans Administration would not allow a mortgage to be provided to a homeowner if there is high voltage transmission lines, within 100 feet of a residential home. The median strip that begins at Falmouth Heights beach and runs to Lake Leaman road, that land strip that would be excavated and utilized for the laying of the high voltage transmission lines, would sit below this tract of land and within 50 feet of the homes that are located on Worcester Avenue and Worcester Court avenue. One of those homes belongs to myself and my brother Robert T. Kickham. I attended the public meeting that was held June 8 2022 at the Lawrence school in Falmouth attended by the Falmouth Board of Selectmen as well as two (2) representatives from the Mayflower company, the contractor for the installation of these lines. The meeting allowed for public comment and the majority of the public that spoke to the board of selectmen and the two (2) representatives from the Mayflower company, objected to this installation of these transmission lines.
